Request: The applicant is requesting a 19' variance from the north side lot line to build a deck on the existing legally non-conforming structure, resulting in an 11' property line setback instead of the normal 30' county setback requirement.

**Background:**

The subject property is in the Placer Valley Subdivision, near Alma. A Vicinity Map is included as Attachment 2. The dwelling located on the parcel was built in 1974, prior to the Park County Building Department creation, it is considered legally non-conforming. The home was built well within the current county setbacks and is located approximately 13 feet from the north side lot line. Any addition in any direction, except the south where a grove of Aspens is located, where the existing stairs leading to the deck on the east side, and where the driveway is located, would still be within the county setback regulations. The applicant is proposing to build a deck on the west side of the home, the current setback of 13.16 feet would be reduced an additional 2 feet to approximately 11 feet to the north side lot line.

## Land Use Regulations and Strategic Master Plan:

Each of the standards for approval of a variance (Land Use Regulation (LUR) Article III, Division 1, Section 3-100) is addressed below.

1. **A strict application of the Resolution causes peculiar and exceptional practical difficulties or exceptional and undue hardship by reason of exceptional narrowness, shallowness, or shape of a specific piece of land or by reason of exceptional topographic conditions or other extraordinary and exceptional situation or condition of the land:**

The lot has a small envelope for adding a deck or addition, which is further constrained by the home placement, an Aspen grove, existing home stairs to east side deck, the driveway, and other property lines.

2. **The applicant provided reasonable and adequate evidence that the variance request is not a self-imposed hardship that can be rectified by means other than relief through a variance:**

The shape of the lot, along with the original placement of the home, only allows for one realistic and feasible location for the deck addition.

3. **There exists no substantial detriment to any neighbor or to the public by the granting of the variance:**

No substantial impacts to surrounding properties are anticipated. The proposed deck addition would be more than 100 feet from any structures on the lot to the north. No objections from adjacent property owners have been received.

4. **The intent and purpose of the regulation being varied is not substantially impaired or defeated by the granting of the variance.**

Setback requirements are intended to preserve privacy, safety, and spatial balance between structures. In this case, the intent of the regulation is preserved by maintaining separation from adjacent structures.

### Impact Analysis:

No adverse aesthetic or environmental impacts are anticipated.

### Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of this application with no conditions.

**#10: Referencing Section 5-304, specifically table 5-304a which sets up setbacks for residential lots at 30 feet for the front and sides and 20 feet for the rear. We are using the 30 feet side setback as our setback we wish to vary. The reason for this is because the existing structure comes within 14 feet of the property line already. Any addition in any direction except to the south will still be within this setback and the most logical direction is to the west (where we propose to go). We propose to continue in the westerly direction and the final distance to the property line will be approximately 11 feet.**

**#11: The criteria of 3-100B applies to our request in this way:**

**B. Variance Approval Criteria (paraphrased):**

- 1. Exceptional Conditions:** the shape and topography of the lot only allows for any variance/addition in the direction (west) that we are proposing; no other direction is feasible or realistic.
- 2. Adequate evidence:** This request is not a self-imposed hardship; it is based on existing conditions.
- 3. Neighbors:** There is no substantial detriment to any neighbors or to the public.
- 4. Intent:** Our intent and purpose of the regulation being varied is not substantially impaired or defeated.

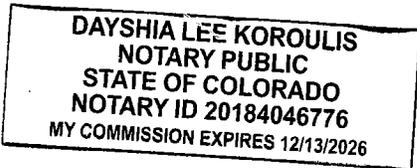

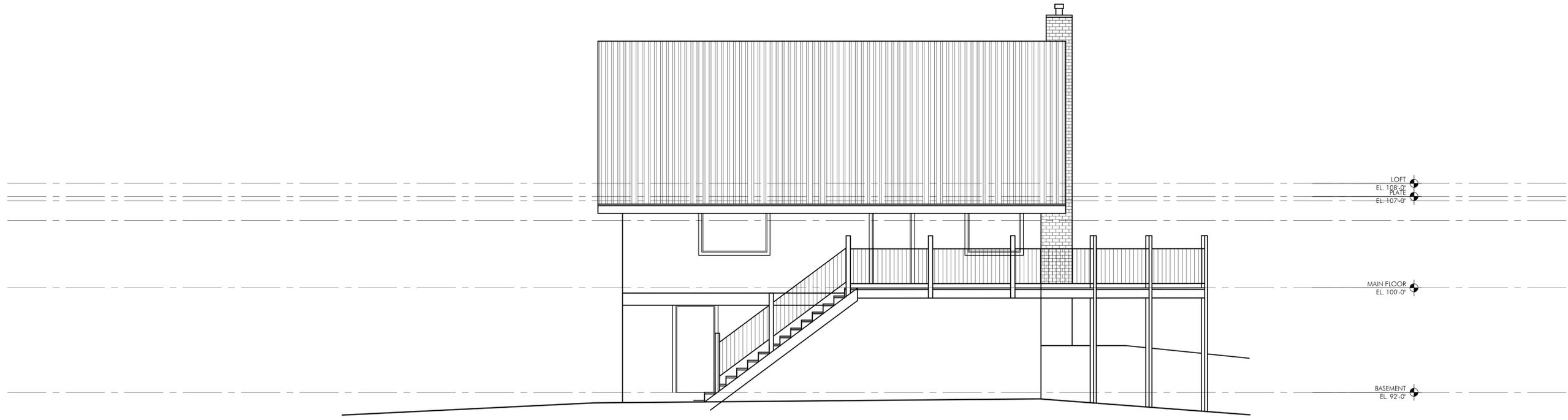

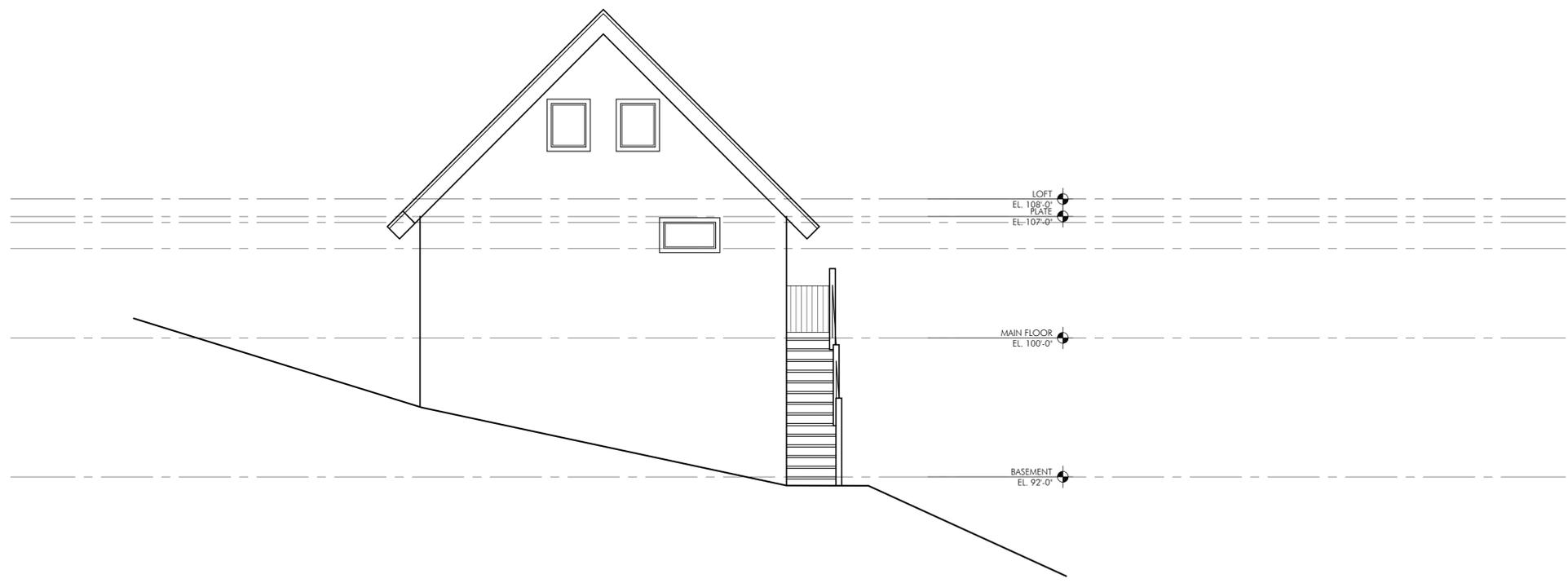








1 ELEVATION

Subject: Langer Variance

Request: The applicant is requesting a 19' variance from the side lot line and a 5' setback variance from the front property line to build an addition on the existing legally non-conforming structure, resulting in an 11' setback from the side property line and a 25' setback from the front lot line instead of the normal 30' county setback requirement.

**Background:**

The subject property is in the Harris Park Subdivision, near Bailey. A Vicinity Map is included as Attachment 2. A conditions map of the subject property and surrounding parcels is included as Attachment 3. The applicant bought the property in 2018. The home was built in 1956, well before the Park County Building department was created in 1975. The legally non-conforming home was built approximately 6 feet from the west lot line. The current home is approximately 25 feet from the neighbor's home. The applicant would like to build an addition on the north side. The new addition would be approximately 11 feet from the east lot line and 25 feet from the north lot line along Anderson Rd. The proposed would encroach the east lot line less than the current home and would be approximately 45 feet from the existing neighbor's home. Staff explored other locations for the addition at the site, however the placement of the septic system, propane tank, overhead electric lines, and the driveway placement further restrict the building envelope.

## Land Use Regulations and Strategic Master Plan:

Each of the standards for approval of a variance (Land Use Regulation (LUR) Article III, Division 1, Section 3-100) is addressed below.

1. **A strict application of the Resolution causes peculiar and exceptional practical difficulties or exceptional and undue hardship by reason of exceptional narrowness, shallowness, or shape of a specific piece of land or by reason of exceptional topographic conditions or other extraordinary and exceptional situation or condition of the land:**

The lot has a small building envelope which is further constrained by the septic system, existing structures, propane tank, overhead electric lines, the driveway and other property lines.

2. **The applicant provided reasonable and adequate evidence that the variance request is not a self-imposed hardship that can be rectified by means other than relief through a variance:**

This legally non-conforming homes original placement limits the building envelope for an addition being added to the home. Building the proposed to the south lot line is restricted by the septic system, propane tank, and overhead electric lines. Building the addition to the west is restricted by the overhead electric lines and the driveway. The area to the north of the home is the only logical building area.

3. **There exists no substantial detriment to any neighbor or to the public by the granting of the variance:**

No substantial impacts to surrounding properties are anticipated. The proposed addition would be more than 45 feet from any structures on the lot to the east and would encroach the property lines less than the current structure. No objections from adjacent property owners have been received.

4. **The intent and purpose of the regulation being varied is not substantially impaired or defeated by the granting of the variance.**

Setback requirements are intended to preserve privacy, safety, and spatial balance between structures. In this case, the intent of the regulation is preserved by maintaining separation from adjacent structures.

### Impact Analysis:

No adverse aesthetic or environmental impacts are anticipated.

### Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of this application with no conditions.

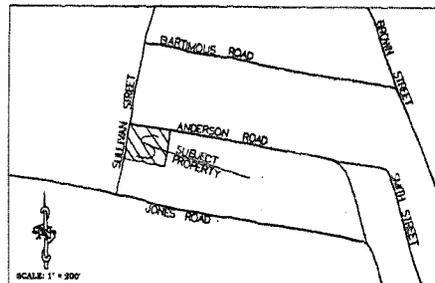

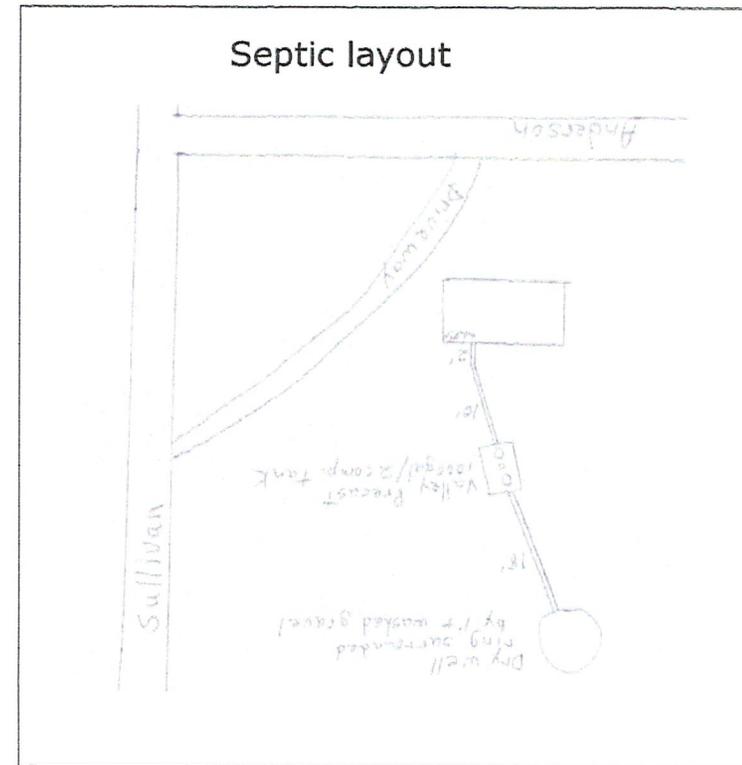

## Current Encroachment on Setbacks & Proposed Changes

The current Right Side Lot Line Setback is 30 Feet. The current structure is 6' 6" from the lot line. The new structure would be approximately 11' from the right lot line which is within the right setback but still further away than the existing structure.

The front setback is 30 ft. The front of the new structure will be approximately 25' from the road. Meaning it will encroach on the front setback by 5'.

# Variance Justification

## Existing Structure Already in the Setback

The existing cabin built in 1956 is already in the setback. While the new addition will still be in the setback, it will be further from the property line than the existing structure.

## Utilities

All utilities are onsite, well, propane, and septic, so it is very unlikely that a public utility would need to use the setback. Should access by a utility need to use the setback area, there is still adequate space.

The electric is supplied by CORE electric. We have included an easement release from them. The electric easement is in the rear of the property and there will be no additions or modifications to that easement or any changes to the electrical running to the building.

## Small Lots

The Harris Park Estates lots are very small and holding to the county wide standard for setbacks imposes a very limited buildable area. It would be very difficult or impossible to add on to the existing structure without being in the setbacks.

## No Impact to Neighbors or County

There is no detrimental impact to the adjoining neighbors, subdivision, or county by granting the variance.
